AFTER-SCHOOL DETENTION AT SMSMCOC

After-school detention is used as a form of discipline at St Mary & St Mina's Coptic Orthodox College at the secondary campus. We believe, in most instances, it will improve student learning by allowing added steps before the student is assigned In-School Suspension or Out-of School Suspension. The Year Adviser, KLA Coordinator or classroom teacher will issue the student with an Afterschool Detention Form notifying the parent(s)/Guardian of the date and times of their student's assigned detention so they can arrange to pick their child up after the detention has been served.

After-school detention will run each Wednesday from 3:30-4:30 supervised by teachers on a rotational timetable in room 4. Parents will be informed of the assigned date of the after-school detention.

When a copy of the detention form is given to the student it is discussed with each student. Students are expected to take a copy home and have a discussion with their parent(s)/Guardian and return the signed slip back to their Year Adviser the following day. A copy is mailed home. In the instance of a student losing their after-school detention form it is the responsibility of the student to approach the appropriate staff member for another copy.

A minimum of 24 hours advance notice will be given to students and parents. Please ensure arrangements are made as after school jobs, tutoring, sports practice, etc., will not be a valid excuse for missing after school detention.
